## TEACHERS' NOTES

This educational resource for the film **The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas** is particularly suitable for English at KS3, although the resource could also be used in any subject to develop students' emotional and moving image literacy. Used in conjunction with Film Education's freely accessible website [www.filmeducation.org/theboyinthestripedpyjamas](http://www.filmeducation.org/theboyinthestripedpyjamas) this disc provides a valuable resource for those approaching Film or Media in the classroom as well as learners studying John Boyne's novel and its context. The disc can also be networked for use across your school or college.

On this disc you will find still and moving image assets from the film alongside publicity materials and an exclusive interview with John Boyne, the author of the novel 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas'. The tasks that accompany these assets are designed to exercise a range of skills as students explore the film from a number of angles including some comparison with the novel.
